MONTREAL, July 26, 2023 - Earlier today, Canada's Walk of Fame celebrated world-renowned Just For Laughs Group /Groupe Juste pour rire with a special Hometown Stars Event, at home in Montreal, Quebec, where the international comedy institution began.
